five Shillings to him this Year &

five Shillings to him this Year

I give unto my son Aaron Anglin
five Shillings to him this Year


Item I give unto my Daughter Sally
Anglin one Feather Bed of Furniture
one Cow & calf one heifer one Mare
called Spot one Pine Chest to her
& her heirs —

Item I give unto my Daughter Catherine
Browning one flux wheel —

Item I give unto my beloved Wife Ann
Anglin all the remainder of my
Household Furniture, my Stock
of Horse Cattle & Hogs so all my
Share of the Crop excepting such
as I have heretofore given away I
also lend unto my my Wife Ann Anglin
the Tract of Land whereon I now live
during her natural Life, and after
her Decease I give the said Tract
of Land to my Daughters Sally Anglin
& my Daughter Catherine Browning
to be equally divided share & share
alike to them & their heirs

Item. and lastly I do constitute and appoint
my beloved Wife Ann Anglin my Executor
of this my last Will & Testament. In
