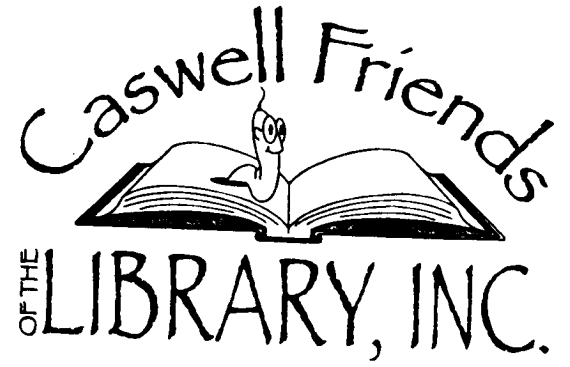

## Past Successes
