

Photo 128. Poteat House. ("Forest Home") ca. 1855. Distinguished example of the Boom Era Greek Revival style house, built by Capt. James Poteat, father of the great educator William Louis Poteat, long-time President of Wake Forest College. The house has a hip roof, exterior end brick chimneys, a well-proportioned trabeated entrance and a 2-story Doric pedimented entrance porch. Extensive remodelling and additions were made in the 20th century.
