## Research Notes: Husband -

Barzillia Powell probably came from North Carolina to Missouri with his brother William B. and settled near Salisbury in Chariton County, in 1837. Then, in 1839, they returned to North Carolina and apparently persuaded their father, Peter, to emigrate with them. This time Barzillia bought and entered land north of College Mound in Macon County, Missouri. Over the next several years Barzillia and his father made a number of trips back to North Carolina. While on one of those trips one of his sons, Henry M., died and his mother buried him under an apple tree in the orchard back of the barn. Some years later Barzillia donated the land where two of his infant sons were buried and one hundred dollars toward the establishment of a cemetery and church. The church that was eventually built was shared by local Presbyterians and Baptists who had been meeting on alternate Sundays in the local schoolhouse. The Presbyterians called the new church Pleasant Hope and the Baptists called it New Salem. Services were separate but Sunday School was combined and the cemetery was shared so the names Union Church and Union Cemetery came to be used. Union Cemetery remains and continues to be used but where the church once stood and where Henry M. and George W. were buried is marked with a large monument on which is carved "ESTABLISHED ABOUT 1843".
