	<p>He served under Captain Minor Huntington's Company for 5 months and 23 days and received \$42.64 for his services. Officers and soldiers were detached from the militia of North Carolina and put under the command of the militia of Virginia. Military support had been requested by the President in 1812 and again in 1814.</p>
