THE CONDITION of the above obligation is such, that if the above bounden *James W*
Featherston

Administrator of *Rubin Watson* deceased, do make a true
and perfect inventory, and account of sales of all the real estate, and all the goods and chattels, rights
and credits of the said deceased, which have or shall come into *his* possession or knowledge,
or to the possession of any other person for *him* and the same do exhibit into the office of
the Court where order for administration passed, within ninety days after the date of these presents,
and do well and truly administer according to law, all the goods, chattels, rights and credits of the
deceased, and the proceeds of all his real estate, that may be sold for the payment of his debts, which
shall at any time come to the possession of the said *James W Featherston*
or to the possession of any other person for *him* and further
do make a just and true account of *his* administration within two years after the date of these
presents, and all the rest and residue of the said proceeds of real estate, goods, chattels and credits,
